It is a well-known fact that the Ovaherero and Nama Genocide is considered as the first genocide of the 20th century. After Namibia gained independence, the two communities (Ovaherero and Nama) took it upon themselves to engage the German government for talks that could eventually lead to restorative justice. This was followed by the adoption of a motion in parliament which was moved by our late President of **NUDO** and this clearly testifies the commitment of **NUDO** to fight for the just reparations of the affected communities and to hold the German government accountable. **NUDO** aims for an inclusive negotiating committee, demand for an apology from the German government, and a just reparation as per the needs of the affected communities.

This manifesto reiterates on the **NUDO** aim of redressing social injustices, imbalances and perpetuation of a class society and dominance of elitist elements in governance structures. We will foster a strong and sustainable economy which encourages the necessary wealth creating process, develops and uses the skill of the people and works to the benefit of all, with a just distribution of the rewards of success. We want to see democracy, participation and the co-operative principle of industry and commerce within a competitive environment in which the government allows the market to operate freely where possible but intervenes where necessary. We will promote scientific research and innovation and will harness technological change to human advantage.

Our case is simple:that Namibia can and must be better. The vision is a country with drive, purpose and energy towards one aim, one Namibia, one people, one destiny and one Africa.

The **NUDO** Party is a party of ideas and ideals but not of outdated ideology. What counts is what works. The objectives are radical. The means will be modern.

We believe in Namibia. It is a great country with a great history. The Namibian people are a great people. But we believe Namibia can and must be better: better schools, better hospitals, better ways of tackling crime, of building a modern welfare state, of equipping ourselves for a new world economy.We want a Namibia that is one nation, with shared values and purpose, where merit comes before privilege, a Namibia for the many not the few, a Namibia strong and sure of itself at home and abroad.

NUDO PREAMBLE:

NUDO is a political party with a social democratic economic development agenda for Namibia. The emphasis lies with the emancipation of the previously disadvantaged African masses. The socialist character is to create a welfare state where the economy is centrally planned and essential services like health and education are free for the citizens of this country. Though **NUDO** has a nationalization agenda for the essential resources of our country, it will allow for the market forces to dictate some elements of development.

THE NEED FOR AN ALTERNATIVE: For too long Namibians have done themselves a disfavor by giving unchecked power to the current regime and this proves the saying that says "everything stays the same until everything falls apart". The current inequality gap portrays that the power Namibians have granted to the current regime has turned it into a corrupt and potentially arrogant and deadly power at the expense of the voters. As a Namibian do yourself a favor and vote for **NUDO** and be guaranteed of a viable alternative government in waiting.

Again, we reiterate that the current development agenda remain unfavorable for the previously disadvantaged Namibians as critical sectors like fishing, agriculture, mining and tourism are dominated by foreign owners and they do little to uplift the living standard of our citizenry. There is basically not clear drive and strategy to empower our people economically.**NUDO** strategy will be using our financing instruments such as the Development Bank of Namibia, and the Agricultural Bank of Namibia to provide free collateral loans to the previously disadvantaged Namibians with lower interest and extended gracing periods.

NUDO is also democratic and against one party absolutism and will fight any sectarian and authoritarian tendencies.

NUDO will stand with poor, down trotted of the world and Africa in particular. Solidarity will start at home were our people have to be molded into a One Namibia and not be distinguished too much by ethnic identity.

FREEDOM we seek a Namibia in which every person has a dignified life, with integrity and whose rights are ensured and protected as in our constitution. Where every person's opinion is respected and is not prosecuted or repressed.

UNITY IN DIVERSITY where everyone will be embraced and respected equally as entrenched in our constitution.

NUDO PLAN TO CREATE JOBS:

NUDO Party will put economic emancipation of the country as a central component of our development strategy. The economic emancipation drive will be broad-based,

focusing not only on the economy but on society, the environment and governance so that it is inclusive and creates sustainable jobs in ways that safeguard environment, and leads to greater levels of integrity.

NUDO economic emancipation strategy will be driven by value chain development because it provides opportunities for expanding production capabilities and jobs. We will implement value chains in ways that allow the performance of the various tasks along the production chain in different towns and regions, depending on their respective comparative advantages.

NUDO believes that through a strong and smart economic emancipation strategy, our unemployment rate will be reduced by 13% as more jobs will be created in various sectors of the economy.

NUDOpromises a better Namibia in its deliverance of the following actions:



EDUCATION

- Reform the education sector through a collaborative approach of all key stakeholders including Teachers and Students Unions, Parents and development partners towards a more inclusive, teacher-centered approach and market-oriented education system.
- Make Grade 12 compulsory again to all learners as the key to tertiary institutions.
- Expand access and inclusion using technology-related teaching platforms.
- Develop requisite infrastructure and facilities to cater for more schools across the country to prevent teaching from under the trees and in tents that poses health risks and an unconducive environment for leaners to prosper.
- Streamline Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) in the curriculum at junior and senior secondary level through the integration of vocational subjects that will realignment with the needs of the economy and positioning TVET as a preferred educational pathway for our youth.
- Prioritize digitization through the provision of requisite equipment, econtent, and capacity building for schools, students, and teachers.
- Provide adequate capacity building to school boards to strengthen their linkage as a catalyst for the promotion of the three-legged pot approach that includes teachers, learners and parents.
- Increase funding to NASFAF and elevate this support in the form of grants to provide for more students that are entering the tertiary institutions and lessens the criteria to ensure that all students in need are catered for.
- Ensure that NASFAF funding to students covers for registration fees and abolish the system of students requiring to pay up for their registrations.
- Increase funding per learner as allocated to schools to provide adequate resources for learner's support and ensure that the burden to parents towards the school's development funds are lessens.
- Ensure that each school has a library to culminate a culture of reading and research by leaners from junior primary to senior secondary.
- Ensure that vocational centers are constructed in regions currently not having any and create conducive environment for private entities to compliment government efforts in TVET development.

HEALTH AND WELFARE

- Provide all health facilities with Doctors, Nurses, equipment's and adequate medicines.
- Construct more modern referral hospitals to ease the burden on the Katutura Intermediate Hospital.
- Give powers to the Ministry of Health in the procurement of medicines and necessities to avert situations were hospitals and health facilities are running out of medicines and care for their patients due to bureaucratic procurement processes by the Central Procurement Board of Namibia.
- Construct a state-of-the-art pharmaceutical plant that will produce key essential medicines for use at our health facilities to minimize the waiting period of procured medicines from abroad.
- Make use of electronic health records so that information on patients, including their medical history, treatment, and medication, is easily available to healthcare practitioners for quick and efficient responses to patient needs.
- Train more medical doctors, nurses and other healthcare giver professions to improve patient to patient-to-caregiver ratio.
- Develop an agile and responsive health system to deal with emergencies, epidemics and other health threats.
- Provide basic income grant of N\$1,000 to persons from the age 18 59 years.
- Increase old age pension by 5% annually and 10% for orphanage grants.



ANCESTRAL LAND AND LAND REDISTRIBUTION

- Restitute ancestral land rights of those Namibians who lost land because of colonial dispossession and genocide.
- Abolish foreign land ownership.
- Put all land under the custodianship of the state for equal redistribution to all.
- Prohibit the selling of farmland either publicly or privately above its productive value.
- Set a capped price for land prices in Namibia at the land agricultural productive value.
- Establish an Ancestral Land Restitution Commission that will ensure a fair and transparent process of ancestral land claims.
- Include a criterion of communities who lost land due to genocide in the resettlement policy.
- Ensure that once a farmland is bought by government, the resettlement process is fast-tracked to prevent vandalism of the farm and to allow for an efficient and transparent handover with a full support package upon allotment for the farm productivity to resume immediately.
- Provide a six-month induction capacity building program for new resettled farmers in farm management, rangeland management, financial and income diversification to maximize on the farm full production potential.
- Monitor and evaluate resettled farmers performance based on a five-year production plan and make provision for further support with key



GENOCIDE AND REPARATION



- Advocate for the involvement of all affected community leadersat the table for a fair reparation talks with clearly defined needs and demands.
- Stick to the 2006 parliamentary resolution which agreed for a tripartite process on reparations that included descendants of victims of the colonial genocide.
- Push for a public apology from the German government on the genocide it committed against the Herero and Nama people between 1904 and 1908.
- Demand for a just and concise reparations for the affected communities including a thorough and long-term reparation agreement that restores the dignity, culture, cohesion, mental state, material and land of affected communities.



WATER AND AGRICULTURE

- Abolish water payment for agricultural use in communal areas to promote food security efforts towards creating drought resilient communities in rural areas.
- Grow the rural economy through agricultural mechanization and tailor-made support to communal farmer in maximizing agricultural productivity of their villages.
- Launch a Rural Economic Development Strategy that targets areas with strong water and support these farmers with a full mechanization package that will allow the farmer to develop water infrastructures, establish crop and fodder production fields and become a feeder farmer for agricultural advancement in communal areas to grow targeted value chains.
- Develop fodder hubs in communal areas as a drought mitigating strategy for farmers and the provision of readily available and affordable fodder to farmers.
- Promote the development of the beef and weaner value chains for retention of weaners and provision of slaughter ready animals to local export abattoirs.
- Foster partnerships between government, private sector, and development partners to promote further investment in agricultural mechanization.
- Build desalination plants and support current and new Green Schemes with financial injection and technical expertise to turn them into meaning full and productive entities that will make the country produce at least 40% of own food and cut reliance from exporting food from other countries.
- Explore more markets for our beef and small stock for farmers south and north of the cordon veterinary fence to grow the agricultural sector contribution to the GDP.
- Promote sustainable control and utilization of biomass resources in communal areas.



YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, CULTURE, SPORTS AND RECREATION

- Build appropriate infrastructure such as incubation and content creation hubs, performing arts production facilities, fine arts studios and galleries.
- Develop creative talent among the youth through the implementation of arts and cultural projects in schools and communities to raise awareness about viable career opportunities within the sector and national pride.
- Nurture, develop, and harness artistic talent among the youth especially, to produce a pool of competent creative artists who can grow Namibia's creative and cultural industries sector and bring economic prosperity.
- Protect the intellectual property rights of creative artists and ensure they are duly rewarded for their work.
- Set up a state-of-the-art High-Performance Centers at various towns across the country aimed at optimizing the performance of our athletes.
- Invest in modern sports infrastructure, including stadiums, training facilities, and recreational centers in urban and rural areas.
- Continuously invest in skills development and training of athletes, coaches, and sports administrators.
- Establish a Youth Empowerment and Business Fund to capacitate young people through training and mentorship, provide financial, material and equipment support to youth viable initiated small businesses.
- Make provision for business incubation centers in all regions to provide for conducive environment for young people to start small businesses for selfemployment.
- Create a broad-focused placement or in-service employment program for qualified youth in the different segments of our economy to gain relevant experience and expertise to maximize their chances for employment opportunities and thus contributing to a reduction of at least 20% of the unemployment rate in the country.



ECONOMIC GROWTH, INDUSTRIALIZATION AND JOB CREATION

NUDO will:

- Develop supportive strategies and legislation for agro-processing.
- Prioritize production of raw materials for agro-processing through low interest rates for local agricultural production.
- Protect and promote domestic producers and boost domestic production of goods and services.
- Foster partnerships between public and private sector to manufacture textiles, apparel, leather, and leather products, and endeavor to use local raw materials.
- Recognize that Research and Development (R&D) is an essential driver of economic growth, spurring innovation and invention.
- Increase access to finance for the informal sector, the youth, micro, small and medium enterprise.
- Strengthen the role of the Development Bank of Namibia (DBN) to better serve the Informal Sector, Youth, and MSME sectors with subsidized interests.
- Empower the Competition Authority to be more responsive to monopolies, excessive economic concentration, and abuse of dominance by large players that keep SMMEs out of the mainstream economy.
- Expand knowledge and skills of the citizens in green hydrogen and create synergies between local companies with international investors.
- Place the country on a strong path to creating sustainable jobs and inclusive wealth creation.
- Prioritize rural areas road network to boost local economy.
- Allocate fishing quotas to Regional Councils and Local Authorities to expand income towards land servicing and low-cost housing.
- Promote local processing and value addition of diamonds through NAMDIA.



HOUSING

- Allocate adequate budget to Regional Councils to resuscitate the Build Together Programme as a housing provision scheme to rural communities in securing a shelter and minimize urbanization.
- Make funding provisions to the Shack Dwellers Foundation of Namibia to complement their efforts in ensuring that Namibians have a place to call homeand to restore their dignity.
- Foster partnership between local authorities and the private sector for servicing of land at municipal, town, village and settlement level to fast-track the provision of land for housing and businesses.
- Introduce a Housing Subsidization Scheme for Build Together and Shack Dwellers Foundation beneficiaries on building materials.
- Provide for fast-tracking of allocation of informal settlement to ensure organized setup and provision of essential services such as water, sanitation and electricity to beneficiaries.
- Introduce a standard construction design model for informal settlements for uniformity, uniqueness and beauty of these settlements across municipalities, towns and villages.







- Protect our fauna and flora
- Continue to develop and implement policies and legislation aimed at reducing carbon emissions and promoting sustainable practices across all sectors.
- Promote for the sustainable utilization of our natural resources especially of resources utilized for economic growth of Namibia.
- Increase citizen participation in the high-end tourism market through concessions and providing support for their growth.
- Promote the development of cultural villages in conservancies to enhance the nation's cultural identity.
- Expand our tourism market through dynamic marketing initiatives that highlights ouruniqueness, beauty and fauna and flora as key attraction propositions to local and international tourists.
- Develop innovative offerings like cultural tours and experiences and adventure activities in rural communities and include tours to our heritage sites for historical connections.
- Foster partnerships between conservancies and private investors through joint ventures to establishing tourist destination facilities in promoting cultural tourism as a growth strategy for rural areas and inter-connecting these with national parks and private establishments.
- Promotes growth, prosperity, and a thriving natural environment for all.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AND GENDER EQUALITY

- Pursue inclusivity through the promotion of gender equality and the eradication of disparities.
- Accelerate the implementation of policies and initiatives to end GBV, and foster equal rights, fairness, representation, and empowerment.

- Institutionalize gender equality throughout the government system.
- Adhere to gender equality international best practices and promote gender equality through targeted economic empowerment initiatives.

Under this new legislation the Anti-Corruption Commission and the Prosecutor General shall report to parliament on a quarterly basis regarding craft and corruption cases.
- Introduce anti-corruption courts.
- Review governance structure and institutions to avert corruption and promote integrity.
- Promote public education and awareness on the effects of corruption on the society, economy, international standing and promotion of integrity and civic responsibility.
